

DULUTH--Ernest Melby, East Lansing, Mich., distinguished professor of education at Michigan State university, will address the annual spring conference for northeastern Minnesota school superintendents at UMD April 17.

The conference will be a feature of Education day, opening with a convocation at 9 a.m. at which Professor Melby will speak. Various student activities, including selection of an E-day prince and princess, will be conducted.

A coffee hour will follow the convocation. The school men will visit informally with the Michigan State educator at this time.
