

DULUTH--In winning the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic conference title and the 13th (Minnesota) district, National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics, playoffs two years in succession, the UMD Bulldogs won 42 and lost seven games. The MIAC titles came with identical 15-1 records in conference play. Last year UMD defeated St. Cloud State college, 71-66, and bowed to East Texas State college, 59-66, in NAIA tourney competition. This year the Bulldogs defeated St. Cloud, 67-65, for the district title and crushed Austin, Tex., college, 87-79, before losing to West Virginia Wesleyan, 90-75, in a second round NAIA tourney game at Kansas City. UMD's over-all record for 1958-59 was 22 and 4.
