

DULUTH--An expanded art scholarship program and Tweed gallery acquisitions are objectives of the recently formed UMD Art Students guild.

Financed through the annual art auction which this year brought \$552, three scholarships will be awarded this summer and next year.

They include \$100 scholarships each to the 11th annual summer workshop in advanced painting July 20-Aug.22 taught by Will Barnet and to the first annual ceramics studio workshop taught by Glenn C. Nelson, UMD teacher and author.

A third award will be a \$250 tuition prize for study next year in the UMD art department. Gallery acquisitions are a future project.

Portfolios and groupings submitted by applicants for the several awards will be judged by a UMD art department jury May 22.

The jury includes R.Dale Miller, chairman, division of the humanities; Arthur E. Smith, head, art department; Rudolph Schauer, William Boyce, Dorrance Kiser, and Mr. Nelson, art faculty members.

The awards committee includes Kenneth M. Johnson, Red Wing, president, and Rodney L. Johnson, Duluth, vice president, Art Students guild, and Mr. Nelson, adviser.
