

DULUTH--A twenty game schedule, highlighted by the presence of the Japanese and U. S. Olympians, will be played by the UMD hockey team this season.

The Japanese will visit Duluth Jan. 30 as part of their North American tour prior to competition in the '60 winter Olympics at Squaw Valley, Calif. The Bulldogs will tangle with the U. S. entry earlier that same week.

Thirteen home games, four with Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference teams, will be played at the Duluth Curling Club. The remaining games; four in the conference, a two game series with NCCA champion North Dakota and a singleton with the Warroad Lakers will be road affairs.

The Lakers, annual opponents for the Bulldogs, visit for a pair as do the Michigan Tech JV, and Fort William Hurricanes. The only newcomers to the schedule are the Minneapolis Millers of the Central U. S. League.

The Bulldogs played the Lakers last fall, the Tech JV in '57 and the Hurricanes back in '53.

UMD will be striving for its fifth straight conference title against St. Thomas, Macalester, St. John's, and St. Mary's at home; Augsburg, Concordia, Hamline and Gustavus on the road. The Bulldogs have a 42-game MIAC winning streak, with their last setback coming in the latter part of the '54 season.

With new coach Ralph Romano at the helm, the Bulldog pucksters will report for practice Nov. 16 in preparation for their season opener Dec. 4 against the Hurricanes.

The Bulldogs sported a 10-8-1 record last fall-winter.
