DULUTH. . . The University of Minnesota's first annual Seaway Institute has been postponed to January 16-18, UMD Provost Raymond W. Darland announced today. The institute originally had been scheduled for September 12-16.

"Due to the pressures of the current shipping season," Dr. Darland said, "the planning committee thought it expedient to postpone the Seaway Institute. I am sure the new dates will be more convenient to officials in the transportation and allied industries."

The institute in January at the University's Duluth campus will be sponsored by the University Center for Continuation Study, Minneapolis, and the Social Sciences Division at UMD. It will be dedicated toward solution of the problems of developing international trade at a seaway port.

Dr. Darland said the same general program will be presented in January with top speakers from government, transportation and shipping industries scheduled for appearance.
