DULUTH--One hundred three Boy Scout executives from throughout Region Ten plus five national officials will attend a five day conference at UMD August 27-31.

Held every four years, the regional sessions will be hosted locally by the Lake Superior Council, which headquarters in Duluth.

Region Ten is composed of Minnesota, North Dakota, South Dakota, and parts of Montana, Wisconsin and Michigan.

The program will include a variety of talks by regional and national executives plus panel discussions relative to Scouting problems. All the sessions will be held at UMD's Kirby Student Center.

A tour of the Duluth-Superior harbor is set for the executives and their wives the evening of August 29. Following the conference, all the participants have been invited to visit the Boy Scout canoe base near Ely. Some families will take canoe trips into the wilderness area.
