DULUTH--Results of the 1960 Northern Minnesota Vacation-Travel survey will be released at a UMD luncheon meeting Tuesday, March 28.

Social sciences professor Richard O. Sielaff will deliver his findings at 12:30 p.m. in Kirby Student Center ballroom. The meeting is the second in a spring luncheon-lecture series of the University of Minnesota Research Trust Fund, devoted to topics in the social sciences and business.

Sielaff's survey of trends in outdoor recreation was financed by the Minnesota Arrowhead Association and the Iron Range Resources and Rehabilitation Commission. It is a followup on the comprehensive 1958 study.

Sielaff is chairman of the UMD Social Sciences division and professor of business and economics. He conducts a summer seminar on Duluth area business and recreation.

Also attending the meeting will be Marvin Lundin, new MAA executive secretary, and members of UMD social sciences honoraries.
