DULUTH--Dr. George E. Reynolds, one of the foremost figures in music education, will conduct UMD's fourth annual high school Honor Band Clinic Tuesday (Feb.13) in Kirby Student Center Ballroom.

The clinic sessions, scheduled from 9:30 a.m. until noon and 1:30 p.m. until 4 p.m. will be followed by a University band concert at 7:30 p.m. under Associate Professor James Murphy with the Honor Band participating.

Dr. Reynolds, editor of "Brass Workshop" in the School Musician Magazine, is a leading brass instructor, clinician and band director. He presently serves on the staff at Bowling Green State University in Ohio.

Works by Rossini, Paul Creston, Morton Gould, Neil McKay and William Schumann have been chosen for the UMD concert. Loy Kay Clemmons, Duluth, will be the featured soloist in Richard Strauss' "Eb Major Horn Concerto" and David Cran, Duluth; William Lavato, Eveleth; and William Tormondsen, Lutsen, will perform Agostini's "The Three Trumpeters."
