DULUTH--UMD's 1961 Central United States Intercollegiate 4 Events Championship has been forfeited to Michigan Tech, it was announced today by University officials.

The use of an ineligible performer, Roger Torguson, was cited as the reason. It was discovered that Torguson, who registered in the winter of 1961 as a first quarter freshman had attended South Dakota State College of Agriculture in 1957-58, and thus was ineligible for varsity competition for a full semester.

Registration officials at UMD recently discovered that Torguson had withheld information. They reported their findings to Ski Coach Dr. Ward Wells who, after consultation with the Faculty Athletic Committee, decided on the forfeit and return of the championship trophy to runnerup Michigan Tech.
