Purpose of the conference is to bring together subject matter teachers, instructors and college professors to discuss common problems and transition difficulties for students going from high school to college.

Sigurd Ode, principal of Morgan Park High School, will speak on "The Needs of the Educational Product."

Divisional meetings will begin at 11:00 a.m. Division Chairmen and discussion topics are: Dr. William Rosenthal, head of the English department at UMD, English; Dr. Gerhard E. vonGlahn, head of political science at UMD, social sciences; Dr. John E. Hafstrom, head of mathematics and engineering at UMD, mathematics; Dr. Theron O. Odlaug, head of biology at UMD, science; James Comeaux, assistant professor of languages at UMD, languages; and Havard Archerd, head of admissions and records at UMD, college admissions.

After lunch at Kirby cafeteria, divisional meetings will continue until adjournment at 3:30 p.m. Written reports on the overall conference will be sent to delegates by mail at a later date.
