DULUTH--Four UMD buildings have been given new names, Provost Raymond W. Darland announced today. All are located on the new campus.

The men's residence hall, formerly designated as Unit A, will be called Vermilion Hall. The building houses 56 men, a head residence counselor and the UMD Health Service.

The women's residence hall, formerly called Unit B, will be known as Burntside Hall. It houses 116 women and a head counselor.

Science Addition is being changed to Science-Mathematics building. It has the offices of the provost, academic dean, the Division of Science and Mathematics, geology department and mathematics and engineering department.

The recently purchased Westin home on College Street will be called the UMD Communications Center. By late July, it will be occupied by the UMD News Service, Alumni Relations office, the Statesman (student newspaper\_ and the Chronicle(student yearbook).
