DULUTH--A few reservations are still open for the Duluth General Extension Division summer tour to America's Western Frontiers and Hawaii July 17-Aug. 14.

The 1961 excursion, a part of UMD's Social Sciences 85 course, costs \$650 exclusive of tuition and will be headed by Dr. Maude Lindquist, University of Minnesota tour director and head of UMD's history department.

The trip takes in points West including the Air Force Academy, gold rush country, national parks and Los Angeles. Traveling students will then board a jetliner for the 50th state. In Hawaii they will be guests at a luau, or island feast, Waikiki Beach, floral gardens and historic sites.

The Western Frontiers trip is the eighth in a series conducted by Dr. Lindquist. In 1958 she led a round-the-world tour. She plans a Caribbean Cruise next Christmas aboard the Norwegian ship "Oslofjord," and a summer, 1962 excursion to Mexico and South America.
