DULUTH--A Gregg Johnson Memorial Music Loan Fund has been established at UMD, Provost Raymond W. Darland announced today.

An initial donation of \$1,000 has been given by Mrs. Myrtle Hobbs Johnson, 2714 East 2nd St., Duluth in memory of her son.

Applicants for loans from the fund must be enrolled in UMD's music curriculum following recommendations from members of the Department of Music.

Mrs. Johnson resigned in 1959 after 25 years teaching voice at UMD and Duluth State Teachers College. During that period, she loaned money to more than 280 students from a fund she set up, then called the Gregg Music Loan Fund.
