Miss Krogh, a junior, is majoring in music and has a minor in history. She is treasurer of Sigma Alpha Iota, music fraternity, and a member of the Wesley Foundation. She is a church organist and an adviser to YWCA junior high school teenagers in Cromwell.

At Cromwell High School, where she graduated in 1961, she was a member of both band and chorus, edited the yearbook, worked on the school newspaper and was a member of the student council.

To achieve "advanced standing in performance" a student must pass rigid requirements in sight-reading, play compositions representing various stylistic periods, present a self-prepared work, and give evidence of superior knowledge in general performance techniques.
