Duluth -- Winter quarter enrollment at UMD is 4,344 undergraduate students, 209 or 5% above the figure for the same quarter last year, according to Provost Raymond W. Darland.

Eighty-one graduate students bring the overall winter quarter total to 4,425 as compared with 4,200 in 1966

Darland said both the undergraduate and graduate totals are record highs for UMD for winter quarter.

Among UMD undergraduates, 2,665 are men and 1,679 are women.

Winter enrollment for all University of Minnesota campuses is 40,701, which is 1,067 or 2.7% above the same period in 1966, according to Recorder W. Donald Beaty. He said 1,250 new students registered for winter quarter, down 40 from a year ago.

Men outnumber women about two to one for all University campuses.
