Duluth-- Enrollment for the second, five-week term of UMD's Summer Session reached a new high of 1,158 students, according to Provost Raymond W. Darland.

The 1,158 figure, which includes 125 graduate students, represents a 6% increase over the same period last year.

Enrollment for both UMD Summer Session terms is 2,756, almost 6% above the 1966 total and an all-time high at UMD.

Second term enrollment for all campuses of the University is 10,887, which is 259 or 2.5% above the same term a year ago, according to W. Donald Beatty, University recorder.

It is the 14th consecutive Summer Session term in which there has been an increase, Beatty said.

All-University enrollment for both 1967 terms is 25,466, 220 higher than last year.
