DULUTH -- UMD students will be given two opportunities to take the Peace Corps Placement Test under the newly-initiated "Nation-Wide On-Campus" testing program.

The first test is scheduled for 9:15 p.m. Saturday, February 26, in Room 102, Social Science building. The second date is April 30.

Students interested in taking the test should pick up a questionnaire and sign up for either date in the Counseling Office, 150 Kirby Student Center. No-one will be admitted to the test unless they have completed the questionnaire.

The test is non-competitive and is used by the Peace Corps in its training program and is not necessary to the selection process. Completion of the test does not commit the applicant to service in the Corps or insure selection for a training assignment.

According to a recent announcement, the "Peace Corps is not seeking to notify students of the disposition of their applications within six weeks of its submission."
