DULUTH -- Students, faculty and campus religious advisors from UMD and Wisconsin State University at Superior will take part in a "Consultative Conference on Multi-Faith Facilities" Friday and Saturday (Feb. 11-12).

The first session is scheduled for 9 a.m. Friday on the Wisconsin State campus followed by a 2:30 p.m. meeting at UMD.

A group of resource people from throughout the Midwest will be present to hear opinions and discuss the feasibility of a campus facility that would serve students of all religious faiths.
