Duluth--- An all-time high in UMD Summer Session enrollment--made possible by a $15\frac{1}{2}$ % jump in second term attendance--was announced today by UMD Provost Raymond W. Darland.

A total of 1,092 students, including 130 graduate students, are presently attending classes. Last summer's second term drew 945. The record total of 2,597 for both terms of UMD Summer Session compared with 2,453 last summer.

Second term for all four University campuses reached 10,628,880 [?] students or 8% over 1965, according to W. Donald Beatty, University Recorder.

It was the 13th consecutive summer term in which the total University attendance has shown an increase.
