DULUTH --- An exhibition of student work from the annual Summer Workshop in Painting and a show entitled "Birds, Birds, Birds" are scheduled for Tweed Gallery during late August.

Workshop paintings will be shown August 18-19 with a reception from 8-10 p.m. the first day.

Henry Pearson of New York is the visiting artist/instructor who has been directing and developing the students' talents during second term.

"Birds, Birds, Birds" will run from August 20 through September 18. It is an exhibition of paintings, drawings and sculpture of birds by a number of artists.

Mrs. Carl R. Nelson, Jr. of Winnipeg will contribute the greatest number of works to the show. She will send 15 watercolors of waterfowl.

Other contributors include William Crutchfield of the Minneapolis School of Art, Bernard Quick and Mildred Loecher of Duluth and Sid Fossum of Minneapolis.

William Boyce, associate professor of art and associate director of Tweed, has scheduled "Birds" to coincide with the national meeting of The American Ornithologists' Union to be held at UMD September 5-9.

Tweed Gallery is open from 7:45 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday and 2-5 p.m. Saturday and Sunday.
