Duluth--- Intellectual, social and recreational activities of UMD students will be highlighted on a half hour television show at 8 p.m. Wednesday (Nov. 16) on WDSE-TV, Duluth educational station.

"Spotlight on Students" is the first in a series of six weekly showings each Wednesday emphasizing UMD campus life.

The series is sponsored as a public service by Minnesota Power and Light Company, Duluth.

Joseph P. Zesbaugh, UMD instructor in speech, will host the show Wednesday which will not only describe student activities but also touch on student thinking ~~in~~ of national and international affairs, campus problems, and religious and social topics.
