Duluth--- "UMD and the Community" will be featured on a half hour television show on WDSE-TV, Duluth educational station, at 8 p.m. Wednesday (Nov. 23).

It is the second in a series of six such productions emphasizing the activities of faculty and students on the Duluth campus of the University.

"UMD and the Community" will place its emphasis on educational services, events open to the public, and faculty research which have area implications.

A special film will show activities in the UMD Speech and Hearing Clinic; KUMD, campus FM station; the UMD Labor Education Service; the Research and Development Council of Northeast Minnesota; the North Central Forest Experiment Station; Tweed Gallery and other service offices.

UMD speech instructor Joseph P. Zesbaugh will host the show; Mrs. Virginia T. Katz, instructor in secondary education, is series coordinator.
