Duluth---One-hundred twenty-seven graduate and undergraduate degrees will be conferred at UMD Summer Commencement exercises at 4 p.m. Friday, (August 20) in the Physical Education building.

Speaker at UMD's first afternoon commencement will be Dr. Willard L. Thompson, Minneapolis, Dean of the University of Minnesota General Extension Division and of Summer Session.

University Regent William K. Montague, Duluth, will congratulate the summer Class of 1965.

Provost Raymond W. Darland will confer the 109 undergraduate degrees after the class of 1965 has been presented to him by Academic Dean Thomas W. Chamberlin. Dr. Chester W. Wood, director of Student Personnel Services, will present the individual candidates.

Provost Darland will present the graduate degree candidates to Dean Chamberlin who will confer the 18 Master's degrees. Assisting will be Dr. R. Dale Miller, chairman of the Division of Humanities.

The Rev. Roger M. Kunkel, minister of Lakeside Presbyterian Church, Duluth, will give the invocation and benediction. Donald H. Andrews, instructor in music, will present organ selections, the processional and recessional.

Faculty marshalls will be Dr. A. Neil Pearson, head of sociology, and John H. Ness, instructor in speech. Dr. John A. Dettmann is chairman of the commencement committee.

A reception for graduates, their parents and friends will be held in Kirby Student Center lounge following commencement. Tweed Gallery will be open featuring a show of sculpture, etchings and watercolors.
