

The University of Minnesota, Duluth (UMD) is one of the most striking campuses in the nation.

Situated on a 200 acre tract overlooking Lake Superior, it gives UMD students a beautiful view of the bustling Duluth harbor.

It's \$15,000,000 in new buildings are of contemporary design, all inter-connected so that communication and movement is easy and efficient. Another \$17,500,000 will be spent to complete the campus by 1975-5

UMD is one of four University of Minnesota campuses. UMD offers the A.A., B.A. and B.S. degrees to undergraduates in 53 fields of study and the M.A. and M.S. degrees in five fields.

UMD's enrollment is more than 3,700 and is expected to reach the 5,000 mark by 1970. It has 182 full-time faculty members and more than 400 persons on its combined faculty and staff.

It has 75 student organizations, eight sororities and fraternities, nine religious groups, three student publications, KUMD-FM, and the opportunity for student participation in varsity and intramural athletics, plays, musical events, art shows, and debates.

The Duluth campus has become famous for its ideal summer session location. ~~Because~~ The cooling effects of Lake Superior mean warm but never hot days and pleasant nights. More than 200 courses ---for undergraduates and graduates---are offered each year in two summer terms which annually attract students from many states in the nation.

UMD's rapid physical and academic growth continues to enhance the fame of the University of Minnesota, fourth largest university in the nation and one of the world's greatest.
