UMD OFFERS PROGRAM FOR UNEMPLOYED

Duluth -- The University of Minnesota, Duluth (UMD) Center for Professional Development (CPD) will soon be accepting applications for a special training program for the unemployed.

The two week program Aug. 19-30 will provide free training to 12 individuals in word processing, office automation, microcomputer applications, and counseling in career development and job finding skills.

Applicants must be unemployed, seeking full-time employment, have minimum keyboard skills of 40 words per minute, and have a history of previous employment. If there are more than 12 applicants, a drawing will be held to select the participants.

Interested persons must apply in person for the program at the CPD Office, Room 19, School of Business and Economics, at UMD.
