UMD HONORS OUTSTANDING CHEMISTRY STUDENTS

Duluth -- The University of Minnesota Duluth (UMD) has announced the recipients of the 1996 F. B. Moore Award, James H. Maguire Award, Casimir Ilenda Award for Excellence in Undergraduate Research, and honors graduates.

Tricia Tomlinson, who graduated this spring with chemistry department honors, received the F. B. Moore Award. Moore, for whom the award is named, is a professor emeritus of chemistry, and former chemistry department head (1954-1972). He retired from UMD in 1974.

Vanessa Dufault and **Milan Bajmoczy** received the James H. Maguire Award in Chemistry. Maguire is a UMD alumnus, having received a B.S. in chemistry in 1970, and a Ph.D. from the University of North Carolina. He taught at North Carolina until his death in 1989.

Sara Deusterhoeft, who graduated this spring with chemistry department honors, received the Casimir Ilenda Award for Excellence in Undergraduate Research. Ilenda received a B.S. in chemistry from UMD in 1969, and a Ph.D. from the University of Colorado. He is now a senior research chemist at Rohm and Haas.

In addition, **Richard Powell** graduated with chemistry department honors this spring, and **Anglea Simonsen** graduated with chemistry department honors last fall.
