Duluth-- "New Techniques in Fabrics and Tailoring" will be the theme of the clothing clinic to be held at UMD July 22-23.

The clinic will be presented by Mrs. Marjorie Arch, co-author of the Bishop Method of Clothing Construction textbooks. She will be assisted by Dr. Ruth ~~Palmer~~^{Palmer}, head of the UMD Department of Home Economics.

The clinic will be of value to in-service home economics teachers and to all other persons interested in the topic, according to Dr. Cyril M. Milbrath, UMD director of conferences and institutes for the University's General Extension Division.

Milbrath said more than half the 100 openings for the clinic already have been taken.
