Duluth--- Enrollment for the second, five week term of UMD's Summer Session reached 1,194 students, according to Provost Raymond W. Darland.

The 1,194 figure, which includes 116 graduate students, represents a 3% increase over the same summer term last year.

Enrollment for both UMD Summer Session terms is 2,957, 7% above the 1967 total and an all-time high for UMD.

Second term enrollment for all campuses of the University is 12,331 13% over last year and 100 above the previous high for second term set back in 1947, according to W. Donald Beatty, University Recorder.

After 1947, University summer enrollment declined until 1954 and has moved upward since.

Summer Session enrollment for both terms is 29,514 or 16% above a year ago and the highest in University history.
