Duluth--- Chester W. Wood, director of UMD Student Personnel Services, today announced the appointment of Havard W. Archerd as UMD Placement Coordinator.

Archerd, formerly Coordinator of Records and Registration at UMD, succeeds John A. Hill who resigned to become director of Duluth's Concentrated Employment Program.

Gerald R. Allen, former assistant pastor at Gloria Dei Lutheran Church in Duluth, will become Coordinator of Records and Registration.

Another addition to the UMD Student Personnel Services staff will be George Wolner, Cloquet. He will work half-time in the Admissions Office assisting with college credit transfer, freshman admission and the high school contact program.

Archerd received his B.A. degree in economics from Hamline University, St. Paul. He joined the UMD Student Personnel Services in 1953 serving as supervisor of Admissions and Records. Previously, he had worked in private industry.

Allen earned a Bachelor of Arts degree from Wartburg College in Waverly, Ia. and a Bachelor of Theology degree from Luther Theological Seminary, St. Paul. He is currently working toward a master's in educational psychology at UMD. He served as an intern pastor at Long Island, N.Y., Bemidji and Burnsville prior to coming to Duluth.

Wolner earned his bachelor's degree from Lawrence College and has done advanced work at the University of Minnesota.
