Duluth--- A variety of historical, lyric and dramatic vocal styles will be demonstrated at 8:15 p.m. Tuesday (Nov. 26) when baritone William Ermey presents UMD's third faculty recital of the year in Education Auditorium 90.

Ermey is an instructor of music at UMD. Assistant Music Professor Terrence Rust will provide piano accompaniment at the recital.

For his program, Ermey has chosen songs ranging from the 17th Century composer Purcell to 20th Century's Aaron Copland. Included will be the German lyric "lieder" of Schubert and Reutter, French "chansons" of Ravel and the dramatic "prologue" from Leoncavallo's opera "I Pagliaci."

A holder of the Bachelor of Arts and Bachelor of Music degrees from Hendrix College, Ermey received his Master of Music degree from the University of Wisconsin. He was a teaching assistant at the University of Wisconsin before coming to UMD.
