Chancellor Ianni met with the Commission between 2-3 pm.

Minutes of March 29 were approved as stated.

Discussion regarding the reallocation memo. It was agreed that priority should be given to an Affirmative Action position. The Commission also supports higher priority to the position of police officer. Maddy will draft a memo.

Information- The childcare survey was mailed to all Deans, Department Heads and Directors. To date, 135 surveys were mailed and there has been a 41% response rate. Surveys will continue to be tabulated. There is a listing of 178 children thus far. There was much confusion surrounding the categories and this may have impacted the results.

Maddy discussed Bob Evans memo regarding the Nonrenewal of Academic Staff. Written notices of nonrenewal to academic staff should contain a paragraph encouraging the employee to list their name with the Career Transition Center.

There has been much interest from women faculty responding to our invitation to receive final Commission minutes. This list now totals #45.
