

HISTOR REVIEW PROSP

Class of 1916

The original tract of land used by the Northwest Experiment Station consisted of 476.61 acres. Permission to use the land for experimental purposes was granted by the St. Paul and Pacific Railway, a part of the Great Northern Railway system.

The first building on campus appeared in 1895. This building served as the residence of the first superintendent. Following the establishment of the school, the second floor and attic were used as a dormitory for girls until Robertson Hall was completed in 1910. The entire area of the Experiment Station was on a treeless plain.

In 1906 the Home Economics Building appeared. Stephens Hall was completed in 1908 with a complete system of kerosene lamps. In 1910 the kerosene system gave way to electricity. This year also saw the completion of the Kiehle Building and Robertson Hall. The Owen Building became a reality some time between 1908-1910.

In 1912 a building was dedicated to the donator of the original tract of land, James J. Hill. Hill Building was completed in 1913. Selvig Hall was finished in 1914 and the Dining Hall in 1920. The Monument for Soldiers and Sailors of Northwest School, who gave their lives in World War I, was also completed in 1920.

The Health Service Building was completed in 1926, the Gym in 1930, and the last building was erected in 1946 and is known as the New Dorm.

Northwest has been served by five superintendents since its founding. T. A. Hoverstad was the first to take the responsible position and served from 1895-1905; William Robertson 1905-1910; C. G. Selvig 1910-1927; A. A. Dowell 1927-1937; T. M. McCall 1937-1956. The present Superintendent, Bernard Youngquist, will direct our promising future that has grown out of the prosperous past.




We are now leaving, hoping that you will enjoy your years as much as we.

The day's entertainment began in the auditorium where the musical groups presented a short program. Then the Home Economics students modeled dresses made in their classes.


