Summer 2006: Candidate Policy Forum with Peter Hutchinson (IP)

Peter Hutchinson co-founded and serves as president of Public Strategies Group, Inc., a consulting firm that works with government organizations. From 1994 to 1998, Hutchinson headed a Public Strategies Group team that filled the role of superintendent of Minneapolis Public Schools. Previously, Hutchinson served as state finance commissioner under DFL Governor Rudy Perpich, and as president of external affairs and chair of the foundation for Dayton Hudson Corp. He earned an undergraduate degree from Dartmouth College, a master's degree from the Woodrow School of Public and International Affairs, and completed the Advanced Management Program at Harvard Business School.
