## **THE UNIVERSITY**

The 1976-77 school year marks the 30th year for UMD as a part of the University of Minnesota system. 1947 marked the beginning of a university that will see 6,500 students this season.

UMD is in the second year of consisting with two "colleges" and four "schools." Students may choose over 1,500 courses in 70 plus major fields of study in the College of Letters and Science, the College of Education, the School of Fine Arts, the School of Business and Economics, the School of Medicine, and the School of Social Development.

Students can pursue one of three associate (two-year) degrees, nine bachelor's degrees, four master's degrees in 19 fields of study, and certification in 10 areas.

Complementing the academics is a full program of extra-curricular activities arranged not only to help the student socially but to aid the student in taking advantage of the unique and beautiful Northern Minnesota environment.

### **NIC — A NEW ERA**

November 13, 1975, marked the beginning of a new era for athletics at the University of Minnesota-Duluth. On that date, UMD became the eighth member of the Northern Intercollegiate Conference (NIC) as its members formally voted for UMD's admission.

The move severed ties with the MIAC, to which UMD had been a member since 1947.

UMD had been a member of the NIC before 1947, but the conference was under a different name then, as all of the members were teacher's colleges rather than universities.

The Duluth State Teacher's College (to become UMD) joined the Northern Teacher's College Conference with the 1932-33 season. Original members were Mankato, Moorhead, Bemidji, St. Cloud, and Winona.

During that time, the Bulldogs had a rich tradition with six football championship titles and four basketball top titles.

## ATHLETIC DEPARTMENT



**DIRECTOR** - UMD's 11 sports men's varsity program and the eight-sport women's program are under the direction of Ralph A. Romano. He begins his eighth season as the Bulldog's guiding force in inter-collegiate athletics.

Romano, a native of Thunder Bay, Ont., is a graduate of Duluth Central High School and UMD, including being a three-year letterman as a Bulldog hockey goalie. After a stint in the Air Force, Romano returned to UMD as head hockey coach and publicity director. He soon took on additional duties as he led the hockey program to two MIAC titles, through four independent years, and three years in the prestigious WCHA.

Romano assumed the duties of assistant athletic director in 1967, and then became the logical choice for his present position when long-time athletic director Lloyd Peterson retired. Since then, a building women's program has been added to his domain and he has also been chosen to serve the WCHA as a member of its Executive Committee.

**BUSINESS MANAGER-SID** - Bruce McLeod is in his seventh year as Romano's top assistant. McLeod is a former Bulldog left wing and hockey captain and is a native of Fort Frances, Ont. Besides control of the department's business functions, he has charge of publicity and aides the director with his numerous duties.

**ASSISTANT SID** - Brad Swenson is in his fourth year as assistant sports information director. A 1973 graduate of Duluth East, he aides McLeod with publicity and statistical upkeep. In addition, he is a member of the campus Athletics Committee as a student and is managing editor of the campus newspaper, the Statesman.

## HEAD COACH

Jim Malosky reached a milestone last season, earning his 100th career victory. He concluded his 18th season at the Bulldog helm with a highly impressive 101-56-8 mark.



Malosky is UMD's winningest football coach, holding a .643 success factor and has coached the Bulldogs to three MIAC championships in 1960, 1961, and 1973. He has also been honored with MIAC Coach of the Year laurels four times - 1961, 1970, 1971 and 1973. Malosky won NAIA District 13 Coach of the Year honors in 1973.

He earned his reputation as a highly successful football mentor at Edina-Morningside High School and Morris High, where his 1954 Morris team won the West Central Conference title in his first year of coaching. His 1957 Edina squad won distinction as the No. 1 rated team in Minnesota.

Malosky is a native of Crosby, Minnesota, and starred as Bernie Bierman's quarterback in the great post-war Minnesota Gopher teams. After a stint in the Army, he earned a M.A. in physical education at Minnesota in 1957 and took the head coaching job at UMD in 1958.

His UMD squads have had six straight winning seasons and during the last five seasons, the Bulldogs have ranked fifth in scoring defense among NCAA Division II schools.

He holds an associate professorship of physical education and teaches in UMD's physical education department.

Malosky begins the 1976 season as the fourth-best winningest coach in the NCAA Division II with 101 victories, and ranks in the top 20 percentage-wise of Division II mentors. His teams rank 11th in the Division in a list of winningest teams for the last five seasons (34-12-2).

## ASSISTANT COACHES

In addition to regular Neil Ladsten, Coach Malosky has added three to the Bulldog coaching ranks. Joining Ladsten, UMD's wrestling coach and a five year veteran as assistant coach, are Barry Becklin, Scott Gernander, and Bob Mechikoff.

Becklin finished his four year UMD career as a middle linebacker last season with his second selection to an All-MIAC squad. Gernander is a high school coach at Tower, Minn., and is a former UMD quarterback of the mid-1960's. Mechikoff, a native of California, is new to UMD, coming to Duluth via Ohio State. He will also double as the Bulldog's Head Swimming Coach.

## **HEAD TRAINER**

Entering his seventh season as the Bulldog's athletic trainer is Don Roach.

Roach received his B.A. degree from San Jose State and remained in California teaching general science and physical education before joining an American Community School in Greece as a physical education instructor and a coach. He returned to the U.S. two years later to earn his master's degree in athletic training at Indiana before joining the physical education staff at UMD in 1970.

While at UMD, Roach has been active in programs involving the mentally retarded and serves as the Bulldogs head tennis coach.

## **FACULTY REPRESENTATIVE**

Dr. Richard W. Ojakangas returns to his position of faculty representative to both the NIC and the WCHA after a year's sabbatical leave from UMD.

Ojakangas holds the rank of full professor in the geology department. He is a native of Moose Lake, Minnesota, and is a graduate of Grand Rapids High School.

He earned his Ph.D. from Stanford in 1964. Ojakangas' background includes study at the University of Helsinki, Finland, an M.A. from the University of Missouri, and a B.A. from UMD.

His long-time interest in athletics began at the high school level where he was a participant in the track and cross country programs.

## **ATHLETIC COMMITTEE**

The Athletics Committee consists of administration, faculty, staff, and students that have the responsibility of recommending policy and to rule on matters such as eligibility, scheduling, etc.
