Women Join Men In Expanded 1983 Classic

The American Family Classic, already one of the fastest growing small college tournaments in the area, has added a new twist in 1983! For the first time in the three-year history of the event (two as the American Family Classic and one as the Tip-off Classic), the tournament has been expanded to include a four-team women's division to go with the existing four men's squads. This makes the Classic one of the few co-ed tournaments of its kind in the country!

New faces are in abundance in the men's field as three newcomers -- Upper Iowa University, the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee, and Lakehead University -- join three-time champion UMD in the race for the 1983 Classic crown. This weekend's tournament is the season opener for two of the schools while the other, Lakehead University, is well into its 1983-84 schedule. That, among other things, may make the Nor'Westers the team to beat in this year's Classic.

"I look for the Classic to be a very competitive tournament," commented veteran UMD Coach George Fisher earlier this week. "I think Lakehead, with the game experience it already has under its belt this season, has to be considered one of, if not the tournament favorite. But I wouldn't count any of the teams out of this one."

The Bulldogs, who have put together back-to-back 24-5 seasons, will open against Upper Iowa at 8 o'clock Friday, immediately after the 6 p.m.

matchup between Lakehead and UW-Milwaukee, a team which is beginning what coaches like to refer to as a rebuilding year. The winners of the opening round will advance to the championship at 8 p.m. Saturday with the losers vying for consolation honors at 3 o'clock Saturday afternoon.

On the women's side, all four teams seem to be very much in the running for the inaugural trophy. UMD, coming off its best year ever last season when it compiled a 20-10 record, will get tested right away when the Bulldogs tangle with UW-Stevens Point, a perennial powerhouse in the Wisconsin Women's Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (WWIAC) at 3 p.m. Friday. The entire tournament kicks off at 1 p.m. with the Lady Bison of the University of Manitoba squaring off against the Lady Mavericks of Mankato State. Those victorious in the first round will play for the championship at 6 p.m. Saturday while the women's consolation contest is slated for 1 o'clock that day.

"Mankato State, as far as I know, didn't lose a whole lot of personnel from a year ago and should be a legitamate contender for this tournament," said Bulldog Coach Linda Larson. "I haven't heard much about Manitoba, but they've turned out some fine teams in the past, and I don't imagine this season will be an exception. Stevens Point is a very tall team, which should make for an interesting match with a team that relies on quickness like us."
