# Seventh Annual Alpha Lambda Delta Pi Run

Alpha Lambda Delta (ALD) at the University of Minnesota Crookston is hosting the seventh annual Pi Run on Saturday, April 22, 2017. The run starts at Highland School, 801 Central Avenue North, Crookston, Minn. Races include the 3.14 mile "Pi Run/Walk" (a distance roughly equal to 5 kilometers) and the 6.28 mile "2Pi Run" (approximately 10k). Prior to the Pi Run, there will be a "Slice of Pi" kids run which is approximately one-half mile.

The schedule for the morning begins at 8:30 a.m. with registration at the Highland School. The Slice of Pi kids run will start at 9:30 and the 5k and 10k at 10 a.m. Participants will be able to register on the day of the race. However, registration by April 7, 2017, guarantees 5K and 10K runners a participant shirt. Awards will be presented to the top three overall female and male finishers at the conclusion of the 5k and 10k, and all participants are invited to enjoy our pie social after the race. All children participating in the Fun Run will receive a finisher's medal.
