# Equine Exploration Days

The University of Minnesota Crookston will host two free weekend events in March for college transfer and high school students who may be interested in earning a bachelor's degree in equine science at the U of M Crookston. Equine Exploration Days are scheduled for college transfer students on Friday, March 2, and Saturday, March 3, and for high school juniors on Friday, March 23, and Saturday, March 24.

Attendees will explore the equine science industry and related career opportunities through hands-on labs and interactions with horses. They also will meet with faculty members teaching in the equine science major. Transfer students will learn about the transfer process. Activities begin each weekend on Friday at 2 p.m. and continue through the afternoon on the following Saturday. Overnight stay on Friday night in campus residence halls is included at no cost, as is free admission to the Intercollegiate Horse Show Association (IHSA) equestrian competition on Saturday. Additionally, attendees will have the opportunity to meet with the head coach of the U of M Crookston Equestrian Team. Attendees' only cost is their own transportation to and from the University of Minnesota Crookston.
