Throughout the upcoming summer, the University of Minnesota Crookston will be hosting a variety of camps and clinics. There will be three youth camps, five youth clinics, as well as five adult clinics.

Youth Day Camps:

The youth day camps will take place from 9 a.m. – 4 p.m. on Wednesday, June 12, Monday, July 15, and Monday August, 5. Kids from the age of 7-17 can come enjoy a day of horseback related activities.
