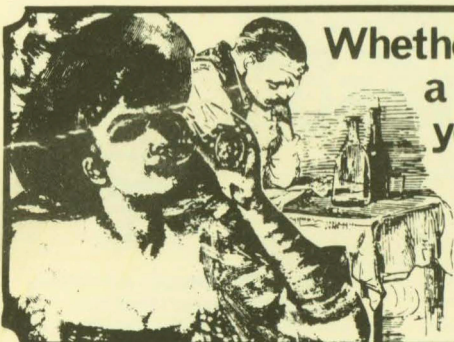

# Today's Game

In discussing the 1982 Northern Intercollegiate Conference, most forecasters predict a showdown between UMD and Moorhead State on October 2 to decide the championship, with UM-Morris given an outside chance of nudging its way into first place.

But even if the Bulldogs and Dragons are the pre-season favorites, Southwest State looms as a real darkhorse, and the momentum it has been building under the guidance of Coach Gary Buer is beginning to produce results. Last season the Golden Mustangs produced their first winning record (6-4) in 14 years.

While Bulldog Coach Jim Malosky acknowledges that UMD, Moorhead, and UM-Morris have dominated play in the NIC in recent years, he's sending out ample warning that Southwest is for real.

"If anybody in our conference takes them lightly this year, they're going to get beat," Malosky said. "Buer has done a fantastic job of building the program, and their kids have tasted a little success now, so they're hungry. I'll tell you one thing, we're coming into this game with a lot of respect for them."

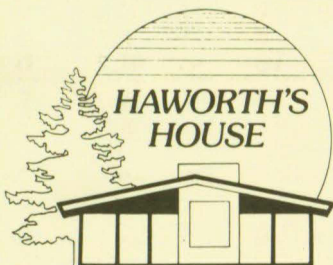
The game is a pivotal one for both clubs. For UMD, it marks the first step in its quest to return the NIC championship to Duluth. For the Golden Mustangs, it is their first meeting of the year with one of the "Big Three" in the conference after its initial 28-16 league victory over Bemidji State last weekend. Southwest now sports a 1-1 record this season after an opening 17-7 loss to Dakota State.

Carrying a 2-1 non-conference record into today's tussle, the Bulldogs' ground game received a shot in the arm last week by the 127-yard performance by junior halfback Prinne Curry, who Malosky is counting on this year to replace standout Tom Stoll. Quarterback Bruce Grant also continued his strong aerial game by completing 11 of 15 passes, four for touchdowns, in UMD's 42-17 conquest over Mankato State. Grant's statistics were aided by some nifty handwork by wide receiver Gene Giles, who made four fine catches, two for scores.

"We started out slowly, but I thought we mixed plays well in the second and third quarters," praised Malosky, who earned his 151st career victory.

The Bulldog coach expects Southwest to rely on an air attack, although he claims the Mustangs have proven they can run with the ball as well. "But the place where they've really improved themselves is on defense," Malosky said. "They set some offensive records last year, but it's the defense that has impressed our scouts."

Should the Bulldogs win today and Moorhead State defeat Bemidji State, it would set up an early-season showdown between the two NIC powers in Moorhead next Saturday at 1:30 p.m.

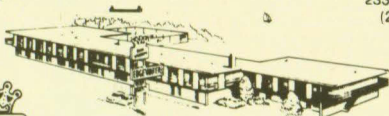

The other players see his example and respect him for it. Last week on his touchdown run, he collided head-on with a Mankato linebacker and knocked him several feet to his back!"

Hanson is a native of Two Harbors, where he was a standout in football, hockey, and baseball. His trophy case is cluttered with All-Conference, All-State, and Most Valuable Player awards!

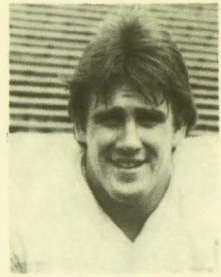
Earlier this season, Hanson moved into fifth place on UMD's All-Time Rushing Leaders' list, and before season's end, he could move up even higher.

Malosky provides his captains with alternates, and this year the Bulldogs have chosen three warriors to share the leadership role with Hanson — guard Gary Birkholz, wide receiver Gene Giles, and defensive end Craig Nasvik.

Birkholz, like Hanson, led his high school team to the State Tournament in his senior year, and he was probably equally as valuable to his school's wrestling program, which he lettered in four times. At UMD, he has earned All-Conference, and All-American honorable mention laurels. A quality student as well, Birk hopes to attend law school.

Popular Gene Giles displayed his finest skills while making four key receptions last week against Mankato, two for touchdowns. The New York native is being touted by professional scouts, and "GG" dreams of someday playing at the professional level.

Nasvik, like Birkholz, enjoyed outstanding prep careers in both football and wrestling, and is a legitimate pro candidate, according to Malosky. Certainly one of the biggest and strongest of the Bulldogs, Naz also possesses excellent speed, quickness, and mobility.

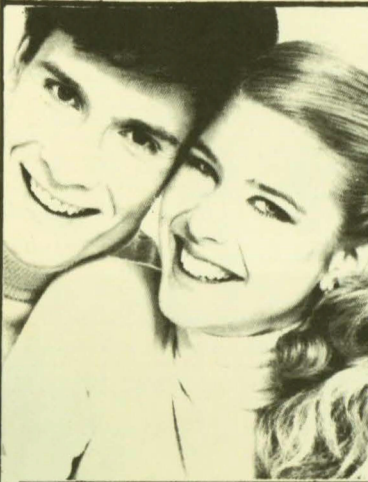

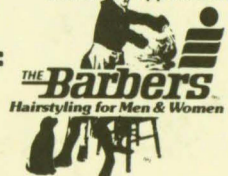

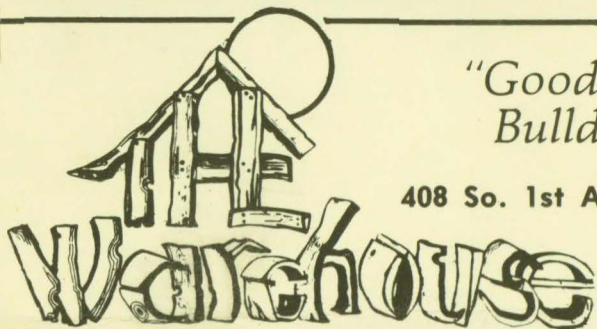
