Bibliographic Search Services

Computer-assisted literature searching can be a most efficient method for obtaining relevant article citations. Whether a comprehensive search or only a few specific references are needed, considerable time is saved by using one of the many databases available. Health science students and faculty often find MEDLINE (or MEDLARS) appropriate for their subject inquiries; however a number of databases provide access to health science and related information.

The following selected list of databases are available:

1. MEDLARS

Scope: Broad field of health and biomedical sciences Secondary Sources: Index Medicus, International Nursing Index and Index to Dental Literature. Years: 1966 to date. Information: Descriptors and limited number of abstracts.

2. BIOSIS

Scope: Comprehensive coverage of the world's biological and life sciences. Secondary Sources: <u>Biological Abstracts</u> and <u>Bioresearch Abstracts</u>. Years: 1970 to date. Information: Descriptors.

3. PSYCHOLOGICAL ABSTRACTS

Scope: Broad field of psychology, psychiatry, mental health and related descriptors. Secondary Source: <u>Psychological Abstracts</u>. Years: 1967 to date. Information: Abstracts and Descriptors.

4. NTIS

Scope: References to all unrestricted U.S. Government sponsored research in the broad areas of physical, biological and social sciences. Secondary Source: Government Reports Announcements.

5. CA CONDENSATES

Scope: World's literature in chemistry, biochemistry, and chemical engineering. Secondary Source: <u>Chemical Abstracts</u> Years: 1970 to date. Information: Descriptors.

6. TOXLINE

Scope: Toxicity, adverse effects, toxic substances, treatment of poisoning, environmental pollutants, and drug reactions. Secondary Source: Chemical-Biological Activities (CBAC), Toxicity Bibliography Abstracts on Health Effects of Environmental Pollutants (HEEP), International Pharmaceutical Abstracts (IPA), Pesticides Abstracts (PESTAB), Environmental Mutagen Information Center File (EMIC), and the Hayes File. Years: 1965 to date.

Information: Abstracts and/or descriptors.

7. CANCERLINE

Scope: All aspects of cancer research and therapy and carcinogenesis. Secondary Source: <u>Carcinogenesis Abstracts</u> and <u>Cancer Therapy Abstracts</u>. Years: 1963 to date. Information: Abstracts.

8. CANCERPROJ

Scope: Summaries of on-going cancer research projects provided by cancer scientists in many countries. Data is processed by the Current Cancer Research Projects Analysis Center (CCRESPAC) of the International Cancer Research Data Bank (ICRDB) at the Smithsonian Science Information Exchange (SSIE). Years: Most current 2 to 3 years. Information: Project summaries.

9. EPILEPSYLINE

Scope: Epilepsy and related topics. Secondary Source: Epilepsy Abstracts Years: 1945 to date. Information: Abstracts.

- 10. POLLUTION ABSTRACTS
- 11. DISSERTATION ABSTRACTS
- 12. EXCEPTIONAL CHILD

Other databases to consider when searching the literature include (1) ERIC (education), (2) INFORM (business and management), (3) INSPEC (engineering), and (4) AGRICOLA (agriculture). Computerized database services also are available at Walter Library, St. Paul Campus Library, Engineering Library, and Wilson Library. If Bio-Medical Library can not provide an appropriate database, the reference staff will suggest one of the other libraries.

There is a charge for computer-assisted literature searching, both at Bio-Medical Library and other University Libraries.

History of Medicine News Notes

Ninety three running feet of rare books from the St. Paul Campus Library are being housed in the Wangensteen Library while a new library building is being constructed on the St. Paul campus. The books are available for use in the Rare Book reading room, but are accessible only through the St. Paul Campus Library catalog.

The fifth floor hall display cases contain works related to the Fall quarter History of Medicine Lectures held Mondays at noon in Room 555 Diehl Hall. The lecture series theme is "The Impact of Science on Medicine," and during the quarter the exhibit will progress from "Diphtheria antitoxin and experimental medicine" through "The emerging complexity of the pituitary gland, 1910-1930."

A student exhibit on anatomical illustrations will be displayed through the end of September. It was prepared by Linda C. Hopwood, graduate student in Library Science, for a course in 17th and 18th century medicine taught by Dr. John Eyler, Assistant Professor, Department of the History of Medicine.

One Cruikshank and three Rowlandson caricatures are now hanging in the Wangensteen Library. They are "the Consultation or Last Hope," "The Cholic," "The Last Gasp, or Toadstools Mistaken for Mushrooms," and "Doctor Convex and Lady Concave," and all four were donated by E.P. Engels, Class of '47.

Selected Additions to the Owen H. Wangensteen Historical Library of Biology and Medicine

Robert B. Austin's <u>Early American Medical Imprints</u>, A <u>Guide to Works Printed in the United States</u>, <u>1668-1820</u> is a standard reference source for rare book libraries that are developing medical <u>Americana</u> collections. Our collection growth in this area was aided in the late 60's by funds from the Mr. and Mrs. John Sargent Pillsbury Fund and has progressed slowly, but steadily, since then. New Publications

National Library of Medicine AVLINE Catalog lists about 2400 audiovisual instructional materials cataloged by NLM from November 1975 through 1976 for its AVLINE data base. The cataloged includes subject and procurement source sections; but title or name index. The 400 page catalog costs \$5.00, and is available from the Superintendent of Documents, U.S. Government Printing Office; Washington, D.C. 20402. The stock number is S/N 017-052-00183-3).

Also available from the Superintendent of Documents is the 1977 National Medical Audiovisual Center Catalog. This catalog includes only items available on short term loans from NMAC. It contains full bibliographic information, including abstract and complete cataloging information. It has name/title and subject sections. The GPO stock number is S/N 017-052-00181-7.

The American Hospital Association has recently published the second edition of Hospital Literature Subject Headings. This edition reflects the many new developments in health care delivery that have occurred since 1965, when the first edition was published. <u>Hospital</u> Literature Subject Headings permits more effective searches of <u>Hospital Literature Index</u> quarterly issues, as well as the yearly and five-year cumulations. The book can be ordered for \$10.00 from the American Hospital Association, 840 North Lake Shore Drive, Chicago, IL 60611.

Catalog Cards for Brandon Core List

For those of you desiring to catalog your basic collection, a new catalog card service is available for those books on the Brandon basic collection list. Cards for titles in both the 1973-74 and 1975-76 lists are available. Cards for the most recent edition are sent unless the older is requested. The cataloging uses the NLM (National Library of Medicine) scheme and uses Medical Subject Headings.

Payment can be accepted in advance or after shipment. All checks should be made to: Moody Medical Library. The cards are sold for 10¢ for each individual set or \$30.00 for the entire list. The standard author, title, and shelf list cards are always included as well as the number of subject cards needed.

When ordering sets of cards for individual books, include the following information: year of the Brandon List from which the title was ordered, author's name, title, and Brandon number. Orders will take approximately one month, unless the order is marked rush order.

COPYRIGHT LEGISLATION

The new Copyright Law (P.L. 94-553) will be in force beginning January 1, 1978. The following documents will help you determine what changes are necessary in teaching and library practices.
