Manuscript Style and Submission Guidelines:

The aim of the Housing Education and Research Association (HERA) is to increase the effectiveness of housing education at all levels, expand the outreach of educators and researchers by coordinating efforts among professionals in housing, develop expertise in housing educators and researchers, disseminate information on current developments in housing, and promote recruitment of students to advanced study of housing in order to increase the quality and quantity of professionals in the field.

*Housing and Society*, a refereed journal published two times a year, supports the mission of HERA by providing for the dissemination of research and other scholarly work. Submissions from a broad range of perspectives are encouraged. Topics in housing include: policy, design, alternatives, social aspects, gerontology, behavioral aspects, energy/environment, equipment, interiors, economics, theory/model development, education, and program development or evaluation.

Four copies and an electronic file (.doc or .docx file) of the manuscript must be submitted to the Executive Editor. All materials must be prepared for blind review according to the *Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association*, 5th Edition. Manuscripts submitted as feature articles will be reviewed by at least three reviewers. Notes and commentaries may have fewer reviewers. Notes are shorter manuscripts presenting succinct information on housing:

- Research—exploratory or not heavily theory-based or statistically analyzed,
- Academic—innovative teaching ideas, or
- Program—development, implementation, and/or evaluation of Cooperative Extension or other housing programming efforts.

Manuscripts may not be submitted to any other journal while under review by *Housing and Society*. If accepted for publication, one author must be a current HERA member. Articles accepted for publication become the property of HERA and may not be published elsewhere. There is a \$35 review fee payable to HERA. Two journal issues are provided to published authors.
