Duluth--- Twentieth century American paintings will be featured at UMD's Tweed Gallery July 7-Aug. 16.

Thirty-one paintings---most of them oils---are on loan from Walker Art Center in Minneapolis. They represent purchase awards made by Walker officials as part of their biennial competition.

A number of 20th century works from the Tweed Gallery permanent collection from purchase awards or gifts will be shown at the same time along with a few pieces of sculpture.

Due to be shown in the Tweed balcony will be 23 lithographs published by Universal Limited Art Editions which are on loan from University Gallery, Minneapolis campus.

On display in the Alice Tweed Tuohy Room will be 19th century French paintings.

Tweed Gallery is open from 7:45 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday, and from 2 - 5 p.m. Saturday and Sunday during the summer.
