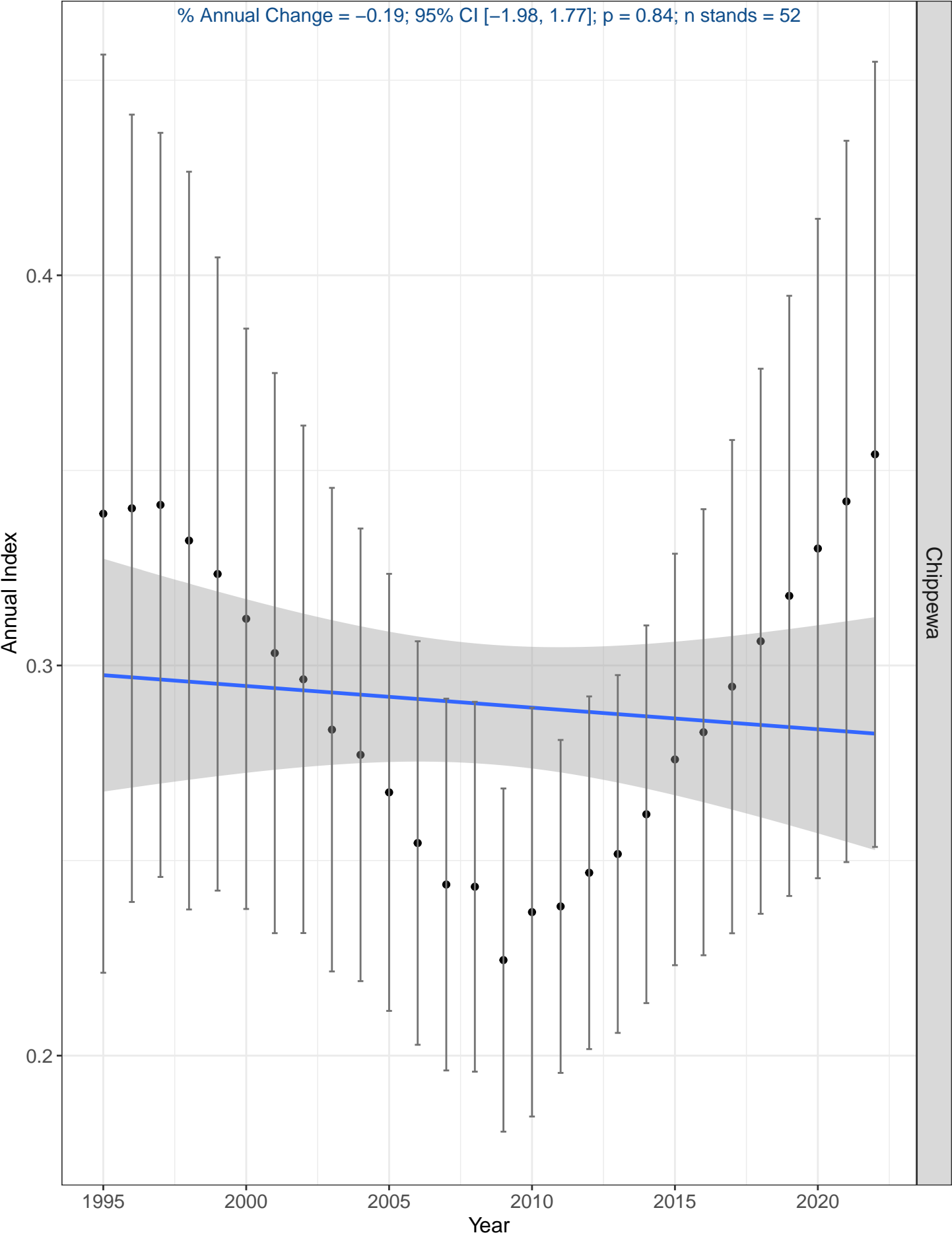


Yellow-rumped Warbler (Myrtle)
