DULUTH -- Eleanor Rynda, an instructor in women's physical education at UMD, has been selected as a coach for the Canadian National Track and Field training camp June 26-July 2 at Edmonton, Alberta.

She will help coach the hurdles, relays and the sprints and will lecture on the pentathlon.

In August of 1964 and 1965, Miss Rynda was one of ten American students picked to attend the Royal Canadian Legion's Track and Field Coaching Clinic in Guelph, Ontario.

A graduate of the University of Minnesota in Minneapolis (B. A.) and Michigan State University (M. A.), she joined the UMD faculty in the fall of 1965 following 10 years of high school teaching.
