UMC Women's Basketball Set to Play Sioux Falls in Quarterfinals of NSIC/Sanford Health Tournament at Sanford Pentagon in Sioux Falls



CROOKSTON, Minn. – The University of Minnesota Crookston women's basketball team will take on the University of Sioux Falls Sun., Feb. 28 at 2:30 p.m. at the Sanford Pentagon in the Quarterfinals of the NSIC/Sanford Health Tournament. The Golden Eagles are the No. 3 seed in the NSIC North and Sioux Falls is the No. 2 seed in the NSIC South.

Tickets for a single session of the NSIC/Sanford Health Tournament are \$16 for adults, \$8 for students and free for children 5-and-under. For fans that want to purchase a day pass it is \$26 for adults and \$12 for students and free for children 5-and-under.

Minnesota Crookston comes into the weekend with an 18-9 record, while Sioux Falls is 24-5 on the season. The Golden Eagles are looking to continue a historic run that includes the most wins in program history, the most conference wins in program history and getting back to the Sanford Pentagon for the second-consecutive year after winning home playoff games in back-to-back years.

The winner of Sunday's game will advance to play the winner of Northern State University and Wayne State College Mon., Feb. 29 at 2:30 p.m. at the Sanford Pentagon in Sioux Falls, S.D.

This is the third season the NSIC Tournament has been played at the Sanford Pentagon. The Pentagon is a 3,250 seat arena in Sioux Falls, S.D. In addition to hosting the NSIC Tournament, the facility has hosted NCAA Division I men's basketball games including Iowa State vs. Colorado, Wichita State vs. Memphis and Wisconsin vs. St. John's, including several other. It will be the host of the 2016 NCAA Division II Women's Volleyball Championship and the host of the 2017 and 2017 NCAA Men's Division II Basketball Championship.
