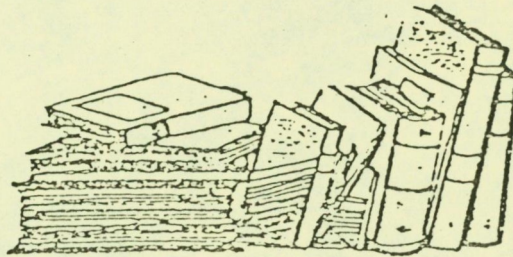
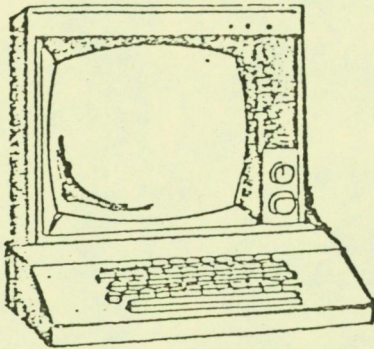

PARTIAL LIST OF JOURNALS HELD BY THE HEALTH SCIENCE LIBRARY

Wondering what journals we have on the shelves? Starting in May, there is a partial listing of the Health Science Library holdings available in the Educational Resources Center. This list will be updated frequently as more

titles are added to our computer database. Only about one-half of the holdings are contained in the list, so if the title is not there, it does not mean that the library does not own it.

SYSTEM 2000 - A COMPUTER LISTING OF TITLES AVAILABLE IN THE LIBRARY

In August 1978, the staff of the Health Science Library created a database to record our periodical holdings. As of May 1980, all of the subscriptions held by the Health Science Library and 500 other biomedical titles are available.

This database is used to produce holdings lists and other specialized reports and is not used online for day to day operations. It includes such information as HSL holdings, holdings of the hospital consortium, prices of subscriptions, subject, publishers, location in stacks, and where the journal is indexed.

As a result of this large amount of information associated with each title, we can produce lists by subject, ranking by price, jobber and many other variables. If you would like to have more information about this database, or would like to see it demonstrated, please call Diane Carroll x8585.
