##### Reinstatement After Sickness

The attention of students is called to the ruling that after absence due to illness, in order to return to class, a reinstatement card must be obtained from the Students' Health Service. When a student becomes ill, he or she should report at once in person or by telephone to the Health Service. The record which is kept on file will then be the basis for any necessary excuse. In case a student should be ill at home and cared for by a physician who is not on the staff of the Health Service, he must, when applying for reinstatement, present a letter from the attending physician or from his parent, stating the duration of the illness and the diagnosis.
