Nordick Named as a Candidate for Hero Sports Division II Hero of the Week



CROOKSTON, Minn. – University of Minnesota Crookston women's basketball player [Katrina Nordick](#) (Sr., F, Perham, Minn./Applied Studies) is a candidate for the Hero Sports Division II Women's Basketball Player of the Week. Nordick is one of 10 Division II players up for the weekly award.

Nordick had a career-high 32 points and added six rebounds and two steals in a 91-90 overtime win over Minnesota State University, Mankato. Nordick was crucial in overtime with nine points in the extra period. The senior forward has had a great season, averaging 17.4 points and 7.1 rebounds. The NSIC North Preseason Player of the Year and 2014-15 All-NSIC First Team pick has scored 1,356 points in her career (ranked third all-time) and secured 616 career rebounds.
