

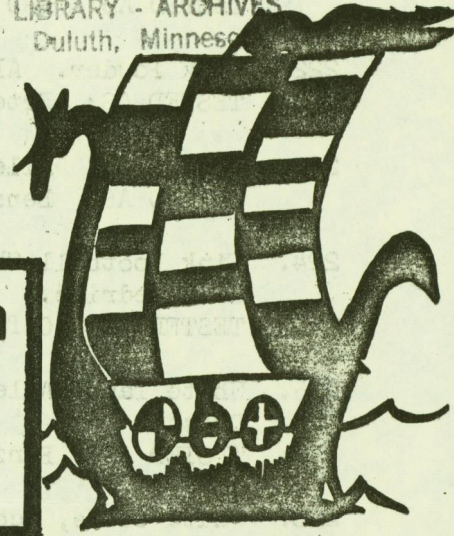

SCHEDULE II FOR SOPORS

Food & Drug Administration (FDA) agreement with Bureau of Narcotics & Dangerous Drugs (BNDD) proposes Schedule II controls for methaqualone. If adopted, Schedule II would require set production quotas, prohibit prescription refill. Proposed regulations will be printed in Federal Register; interested parties will have time to respond, request hearings. Indications are drug manufacturers will fight controls; if hearing result is unsatisfactory, appeal is possible to US Court of Appeals. (Recent 5th Circuit Court decision invalidated hearing examiner's recommendation for controls on Valium & Librium)

Action comes as US Senate Subcmt. on Juvenile Delinquency concluded methaqualone hearings by subpoenaing major manufacturers, Rohrer & Arnar-Stone. Subcmt. Chrmn. Sen. Birch Bayh (D-Ind) castigated FDA for tardy action, claimed "At some cocktail parties, bowls of sopors have replaced peanuts." FEDERAL AGENCIES TAKE STRONG ACTION AGAINST AMPHETAMINE

Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs proposed quotas for amphetamine & methamphetamine are again sharply reduced. Nat'l quota for amphetamine is reduced 39% from last year; meth quota is down 42%. Food and Drug Adm. review concluded that injectable amphetamines and combination drugs should be removed from market, will mount major recall campaign for diet drugs. Recall will be largest effort to remove abused controlled substances from market. FDA also stated amphetamines do little good in obesity control. Study in April Pediatrics journal by Drs. Daniel Safer & Richard Allen concludes that long-term, high-dosage use of amphetamines may cause growth suppression in children.
