## About Our Guest Director

**Sue Gilsdorf** teaches vocal music at Stillwater Jr. High School where she conducts the Grade 8/9 Girls Choir, Grade 8/9 Boys Choir, Grade 7 Girls Choir and the Chamber Choir, a select co-curricular performing group. Her choirs give frequent performances in the community and have traveled to Winnipeg, Chicago, Kansas City and St. Louis. Choirs under her direction have been selected to perform at the state level for both the MN Music Educator's Association and the American Choral Director's Association.

Sue has served as the ACDA of MN Repertoire & Standards Chair for Jr. High and Middle School Choirs. She was part of the group of teachers who initiated the first ACDA of Minnesota Anacrusis Jr. High Honors Choir and was the conductor for the 2007 Anacrusis Girls Grade 7/8 Honor Choir.

Ms. Gilsdorf received her B.A. in music education from St. Olaf College where she studied under the direction of Dr. Kenneth Jennings. She received her Master of Arts in Music Education and her Kodaly Mastery Certification from the University of St. Thomas in St. Paul. She has sung with the National Lutheran Choir and the Dale Warland Symphonic Chorus and is a member of ACDA, and The VoiceCare Network.

In addition to her daily teaching activities, Mrs. Gilsdorf is also the director of the Sr. High Choir at St. Andrew's Lutheran Church in Mahtomedi, MN. She enjoys gardening, reading and knitting and lives with her husband and two children in Stillwater.
